It is customary for member nations of the British Commonwealth to mark various events in the life of their Royal Family, from celebrating their birth through to mourning their passing. It was expected that the passing of Queen Elizabeth II, which we covered previously, was followed by the release of issues commemoration the ascension to the throne of King Charles III.

Among the more popular releases is an ongoing series orchestrated by the Inter-Governmental Philatelic Corporation of New York, who represent scores of postal administrations from around the world, including many British area nations.
