

May 23-30***



The Road to Boston 2026

For eight days, from May 23-May 30, the stamp world will gather for an event that will not be held again in the United States until 2036.

We have been providing coverage of every one of the eleven previous United States Internationals going back to 1913. Each of them share one characteristic—they were memorable events for collectors who went to them!

The Twelfth International will be held for the first time in Boston. It's the perfect place in a year when the United States celebrates its 250th Anniversary and collectors from around the world assemble to join in the celebration.

Every aspect of our wonderful hobby will be available to everyone from non-collectors who want to find out why so many people enjoy stamp collecting, to advanced philatelists who know exactly why it's so popular.

- For many collectors, the main attraction at any stamp show is the dealer section. At Boston 2026, approximately 90 leading dealers catering to every possible collecting level and specialty will be traveling to Boston 2026. The deals will be attractive as they will want to close sales—an imperative considering the costs for booth, hotel and meal costs they will need to cover. They'll also be ready to purchase everything from individual stamps to collections.

- To further serve the interests of collectors there will be more than 20 Postal Administrations, including the USPS and the United Nations—and especially worthy of mention—Ukraine.

- Many of the leading auction houses from around the world will be prepared to make outright purchases or obtain consignments for their auctions. As of March 20, one on-site auction has been announced: Schuyler Rumsey Auctions will conduct a three-day auction from May 25-27. Another house, Robert A. Siegel Auction Galleries, will be offering in conjunction with Boston 2026 the Buccleuch (pronounced buck-loo) Block, the Great Britain “Tuppence Blue”, a bottom margin part sheet of 48 of the 1840 two penny issue, described as “extraordinarily fresh” with never hinged original gum.

- “Extraordinary”—make that “extraordinary plus”—can be used to describe the exhibits that will be on display. Scores of exhibits in 3,500 frames will bring together award winners from major philatelic events, including Internationals hosted by other nations, as well as a literature competition.

If you do not already have a specific collecting interest, a quick walk through the exhibit area will give you all sorts of

ideas, including some built around moderately priced material; and if you already are immersed in a specialty, the exhibits will be a lesson in how to best display your holdings.

Of particular interest will be displays of material—with the dealers and in the exhibits—that go back even before our inception as a nation—exchanges of correspondence among early colonists, our forefathers, signers of the Declaration of Independence, our early Presidents and many other great Americans.

- Still more participants ready to engage with collectors are more than 100 societies, including many with their own booths, as well as others with meetings and seminars during Boston 2026. The list runs from the Allied Military Government Collectors Club through to the Zeppelin & Airship Collectors.

- For youngsters, Boston 2026 will include guided tours for School groups, and Scout Merit Badge programs on May 24, May 25 and May 30. Pre-show registration can be made on the Boston 2026 website.






