

# Bonaparte, Louisiana Purchase, Celebrated at NOLAPEX

With its long history in the greater New Orleans area, the Crescent City Stamp Club, founded in 1932, has changed the name of their annual stamp show to NOLAPEX, to commemorate the philatelic exhibitions of the past that once took place in and around New Orleans.

This year's theme is the 250th birthday of Napoleon Bonaparte, architect of the Louisiana Purchase. The show will take place over two days on Friday, January 18th from 10-6 and Saturday January 19th from 10-5 at the DoubleTree New Orleans Airport, 2150 Veterans Memorial Blvd. in Kenner. The hotel is very convenient to the airport and the show rate is \$109/night.

There will be 16 professional, national stamp dealers selling philatelic material from stamps and covers to postcards and postal history. Other attractions include a youth table and Scout merit badge assistance. The post office will also be in attendance with a sales booth.

The public is encouraged to bring any stamps and covers in for free appraisals and/or sales. The raffle this year is for a White
